The tour follows designated generally single file flat trails or well pounded kangaroo trails to minimise damage to the natural habitat. We recommend wearing comfortable, enclosed, non-slip shoes and layered clothing as the weather can be a little unpredictable at times, don't forget to bring along binoculars, camera and a pen to enhance your experience.
